

Super Walmart: In Keyser—proceed on Rt. 50 east and bear left onto 220/972 north. Proceed about 3 miles up 220. (About 15 miles total)







DIRECTIONS:

Abram's Creek Campground is located about 3 miles east of the town of Mt. Storm, WV off of U.S. Rt. 50.

There are highway department blue camping and lodging symbol signs in both directions along Rt. 50 for the campgrounds. There is also a highway billboard and street light at the gravel road entrance to the campground off of Rt. 50.

Once at the Abram's Creek concrete bridge (labeled), turn off Rt. 50 onto the gravel road for the campground.

Proceed along the gravel road; Check-in/Registration at the 2nd house on the left (not the 1st white house) — as well as brochures, maps, notices & other campground info. After registration, proceed along the main gravel road for about 800 more feet to enter the campground.

CHECK-IN/REGISTRATION/FEES:

Self service check-in located on the front porch of the Lodge House.

Sign <u>Liability Waiver</u> form and place form & fees in secure mailbox on kiosk on front porch.

Cash & Checks only. No change.
