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Hello folks,

This is the latest newsletter for Abram's Creek Lodge & Family Campground (www.abramscreek.com). The past year has included significant improvements to the facilities and amenities for the campground. We now have 10 cabins on-site, 5 of which have full electric, heat, and insulation, with the remaining 5 having full insulation which will retain body heat and safe propane heaters warmth. We have had significant road and parking improvements completed in the past year, and we added a 40 foot covered geodesic dome for hosting indoor workshops as well as an outdoor commercial kitchen capable of cooking for groups of 100+.

By spring 2009, nearly all campsites will have picnic tables and of course they all have fire-rings and benches. We recently added some lighting down the path to the community bon-fire area behind cabin #2 as well as street lighting out in front of cabin #2 --- all spot lighting at Abram's Creek are hyper efficient LED spotlights (using 5 watts of energy and giving 45 watts equivalent incandescent lighting).

There is also a picnic pavilion area and bon-fire pit in the Lodge House backyard as well as a giant roaster grill (uses firewood which is always in abundance).

Accommodations in the Lodge House vary and range from a dormitory bed in a shared room at \$20/night to a private room that sleeps 4 for \$60 per night to a private Master Bedroom suite that sleeps 6 at \$100/night. Private Cabin rentals are available at \$45 and \$65 per night well Tipi rentals are at \$35/night. Camping at one
